

# Matthews

## 2019 Rosé



The 2019 Matthews Rosé was crafted from a couple of vineyards across two separate AVAs in Washington State in the Columbia Valley and Walla Walla Valley.

Farmed using sustainable practices, the vines were hand-harvested early in the mornings between September 27th and October 1st. Upon arriving in the winery, each cluster was de-stemmed and macerated for 14-24 hours; after being drained and pressed, the juice is then settled for 48 hours. Using only free-run wine, it was then moved to stainless steel tanks for 9 months, cold stabilized and sterile filtered. Evaluated over 40 times by our winemaking team, only 835 cases were bottled.

*“Peach, citrus, spring flowers and a hint of a minty chalk. Swirling adds some sweet strawberry, melon and rose water. The palate is juicy and luscious with silky texture, peach pit and white tea. Classic Cabernet Franc Rosé.”*
