2023 Scarline Cabernet Sauvignon



The 2023 Tenor Scarline Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon is inky, concentrated, and unapologetically dark—a 100% Cabernet Sauvignon that layers dark fruit with tilled earth, five-spice, cured meat, and pipe tobacco.

After four vintages with their fair share of drama, 2023 was a welcome return to normal. Typical timing. Typical yields. Typical harvest dates. Boring? Maybe. We loved every minute of it. A steady growing season and cooler finish gave the fruit plenty of time to develop flavor, tannin, and freshness without being rushed.

Harvested in October, the wine was fermented entirely in oak barrels for 14 days, followed by 30 days of extended maceration to build serious depth and texture. It then spent 23 months aging in oak before being bottled on September 8, 2025.

Just 70 cases were produced. Dark, savory, layered, and unmistakably Scarline—the Royal Slope has a darker side.

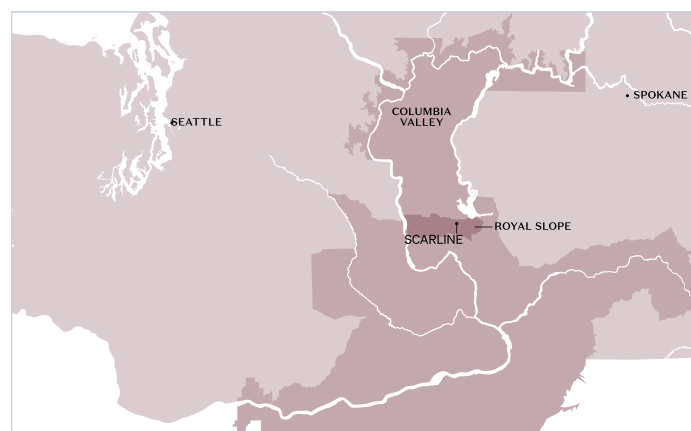
“A gorgeous wine, the 2023 Cabernet Sauvignon Scarline Vineyard is all about refined tannins and elegant yet full-bodied power, with quenching cassis and black cherry. There’s depth and breadth to the background notes of cardamom, clove, and nutmeg, with velvety tannins that nearly taste sweet. It’s all varietal and was aged 23 months in all-new French oak barrique. This is a stunner that should continue to evolve and taste amazing over the next 10-15 years.”
